November 6, 2015 ...for newborns

Panelists and forum participants will explore concerns related to immunizations, newborn screening and infant mortality.

January 22, 2016 ...for early childhood

From topics related to the health focus of well-child visits to our current approaches to daycare and school readiness, panelists and forum participants will explore health during early childhood.

March 18, 2016 ...for the world around them

At this third forum panelists and participants will explore and discuss issues related to environmental concerns that affect the health of children ages 0-4—toys, food, water, and chemicals.

May 13, 2016 ...for their safety and well-being

The last forum will explore safety and well-being concerns. What progress have we made in preventing and protecting young children from physical and mental abuse, in limiting exposure to guns in the home, and in addressing concerns about exposure to prescription drugs?
